


Project objectives

Implemented activities

- **INNOVATION COACH**: Laboratories and Innovation Centre of the Emilia-Romagna have shown the application potential of their research field to the companies and a visit to the CIRI laboratory has been presented (December 2011)
- OPEN HOUSE EVENT: 7 companies competed on the ecobuilding sector innovation application and evaluated by an international team within the ECOMONOD fair context. ABITCOOP obtained the INNOVATION VOUCHER, an opportunity of support from research institutions or private subjects. (November 2012)
- PILOT ACTIONS: rete connections between the research and the companies to support innovation application and job creation (started March 2013)
