TARGET GROUPS:

actors of the regional innovation systems: universities, RTD institutions, business service centres, policy makers, public authorities, SMEs.

EXPECTED RESULTS:

enhancement of territorial cohesion by installing some kind of mentoring system to provide support to less developed regions.

NON-EXPECTED RESULTS:

very high level of interest and high level of expectations about project outcomes from stakeholders.

Slovenia: an innovative "food plain" is going to be set up in order to make the sector competitive and correspondent to EU regulations

<u>Upper Silesia:</u> implementation of a <u>double mentoring</u> system for technology transfer in <u>mechatronics sector</u>
